RELEASE OF LIABILITY WAIVER AGREEMENT

By signing this agreement, you are giving up certain legal rights, including the right to recover damages in case of injury, death or property damage. Read this agreement carefully as your signature indicates your understanding of & agreement to its terms.

This is an agreement between the Undersigned (or minor in my charge) and (the Company), New Mexico Dressage Association.

I, _____ (hereinafter the "Undersigned") on behalf of myself, my personal representatives, heirs, next-of-kin, spouse & assigns HEREBY:

1. Acknowledge that horseback riding is a dangerous activity & involves RISKS that may cause SERIOUS INJURY & IN SOME CASES DEATH, because of the unpredictable nature & irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training & past performance.

2. Knowing these facts & in consideration of your acceptance of this form, I voluntarily assume the risk & danger of injury or death inherent in horseback riding activities. I hereby RELEASE, DISCHARGE & PROMISE NOT TO SUE the Company, doing business under its own name or any other name &/or any of its owners, officers, employees, agents, sponsors & sanctioning organizations (hereinafter the "Releasees"), for any loss, liability, damage, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to my person or property.

3. Release the Releasees from any claim that such Releasees are or may be negligent in connection with my riding experience or ability including but not limited to training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjustment of saddles or bridles, instruction on riding skills or supervising riding activities.

4. **INDEMNIFY, & SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS** the Company & its employees & agents from & against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with any event, my use of a horse & any equipment or gear provided therewith or any acts or omissions of employees or agents.

5. Agree to abide by and follow any instructions given or rules established by the Company or any of its employees, agents or volunteers with regard to my participation in any event, use of a horse or any equipment or gear provided therewith.

6. The Undersigned expressly agrees that the foregoing release & waiver of liability, assumption of risk, & indemnity agreement is governed by the State where the activity is taking place, & is intended to be as broad & inclusive as is permitted by State law, & that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality & enforceability of the balance of the Agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way & shall continue in full legal force & effect.

7. Acknowledge that this document is a contract & agree that if a lawsuit is filed against the Company or its owners, agents, employees, judges or managers for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, the Undersigned will pay all attorney's fees & costs incurred by the Company in defending such an action.

I HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT. I UNDERSTAND IT IS A PROMISE NOT TO SUE & A RELEASE & INDEMNITY FOR ALL CLAIMS.

Venues and Directions

Directions to Vista Sandia Equestrian Park, Albuquerque NM - for Participants/Auditors for October 21, 2017 NMDA Bill McMullin Ride/Re-Ride Clinic:

From I25, take exit 232 eastbound on Paseo del Norte for ~ 4 miles, turn right onto Lowell Drive NE and take the 1st right onto the Paseo del Norte frontage road heading westbound. Take the 1st left after the ABQ fire station, and travel south ~0.2 miles to the Equestrian Park parking area.

Directions to Cool Country Farm, 73 Bosque Road, Algodones, NM for Participants hauling horses for October 22/23, 2017 NMDA Bill McMullin Dressage Riding Clinic:

Take I25 to exit 242 for Bernalillo/Placitas. Take Hwy 550 north/west toward Bernalillo and after ~0.6 miles turn right onto Camino del Pueblo (Hwy 313 headed north). There is a Walgreens Drug store on the northeast corner.

Take Hwy 313 for about 5 miles and after entering into the hamlet of Algodones, immediately before (south of) the railroad overpass, turn left onto Bosque Rd. [When coming south on Hwy 313, this turn onto Bosque Rd is very sharp and without good sight distance (for those behind you), which is why the directions suggest exiting at the Bernalillo/Placitas exit of I25, rather than exiting at the Algodones exit.] Take Bosque Road (gravel) to the end. At the end of the horse fencing on your left and before turning left to go through an automatic security gate, there is a metal stalk arm (about 2 ft long) that is attached to the fencing on the driver side. At the end of the "stalk" is a box. Lift the lid and press the black button, and the security gate will open. Gate is on a *timer only*, so do not stand or park vehicle in gate path as it will close on your vehicle. Marlane Barnhouse's Cool Country Farm, 73 Bosque Rd is the farm on your left.

Directions to Cool Country Farm, 73 Bosque Road, Algodones, NM for most passenger vehicles (cars, and trucks w/o trailers):

Can follow directions offered by mapping/direction sites, which typically suggest exiting I25 at the Algodones exit and turning left onto Hwy 315 then another left onto Hwy 313. Then turning left off Hwy 313 at the Algodones Elementary School and going through a stone underpass (under the railroad tracks). **VEHICLES TOWING HORSE TRAILERS CAN NOT** go this way! After exiting the railroad underpass, passenger vehicles should turn right onto Bosque Rd., then follow the directions as indicated above to Cool Country Farm.
